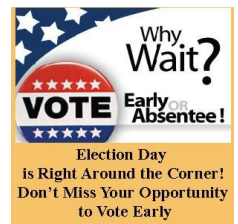

Absentee & Early Voting

Absentee voting on paper ballots through the mail are available for this election and can be obtained by contacting the office of the City Clerk. Absentee voting began Tuesday, January 30, 2018 and Early Voting begins on Wednesday, February 14, 2018. Absentee and Early Voting ends at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 2, 2018. Absentee and Early Voting will be conducted in the Office of the City Clerk at City Hall, 1376 E. Ninth Street, during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. There will be voting during the noon hour.
