Animal Control

All dogs and cats owned by residents of the city of Alamogordo must be licensed through the city. The cost is \$5 for an animal that is spayed/neutered or under 6 months of age. If the animal is not spayed/neutered and is older than 6 months the cost is \$25. To obtain a license you must bring the animal's current rabies vaccination certificate to the Animal Control office at 2910 N Florida Avenue.

The hours of operation are 12:00 pm to 5:00pm Monday through Saturday. City ordinances require that this tag, along with the animal's rabies tag, be worn AT ALL TIMES. If you have questions please call Animal Control at (575) 439-4330.
