Call Meeting to Order and Roll Call.

The Meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. Absent was Mayor Pro-Tem John Van Doren.

1. Discuss the proposed Comprehensive Plan.

Mr. John Taschek of Taschek Environmental Consulting, was present to review the errata sheets for the Comprehensive Plan, as well as his responses to the various comments received from the public, and the revised future land use map. Minor adjustments were suggested for the revised wording covered in the errata sheets. Regarding the future land use scenario map, slight adjustments will be made to reflect even more precise zoning in specific areas. Mr. Taschek pointed out that the green belt area along the Relief Route is a buffer zone and does not infringe upon private landowners' property. Commissioner Easley suggested taking a water/sewer service area map and overlaying it on a City limit map which displays residential areas to create low density and medium density areas. Mr. McCourt encouraged a periodic review of the map every five years or so to address any major changes which may have occurred.

Commissioner Griggs reviewed his written comments and recommendations to the Plan, and all issues were either agreed upon by the Commission, slightly amended on wording, or discarded altogether. Mr. Taschek said he would incorporate all the

changes discussed tonight, and get fresh copies down to the Commission. Also, he would respond to Mr. Michael Shyne and Mr. Paul Burnett in writing, as they were the two citizens that had sent in their written comments regarding the draft Plan.

Mayor Carroll felt they did not need another Work Session like this, although it may take more than one or two Commission Meetings to address everyone's comments. They were not under any time constraint to get this approved, so they would wait to hear from Mr. Taschek before rescheduling the item on a Regular Meeting for adoption.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Adjourn into Executive Session to discuss collective bargaining strategy.

Commissioner Moncada moved to adjourn into Executive Session to discuss collective bargaining strategy. Seconded by Commissioner Easley. All voted "aye". The motion carried by a roll call vote of 6-0-0. The Meeting was adjourned at 8:50 p.m.

The Governing Body of the City of Alamogordo, New Mexico, hereby states that its specially scheduled meeting of May 2, 2000 was adjourned into executive session and the matters discussed in the closed meeting were limited only to those specified in the motion for closure.

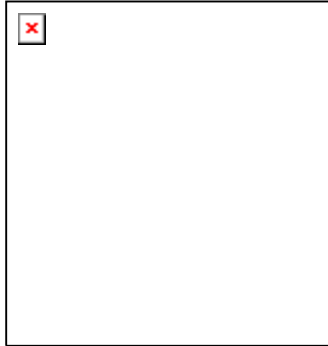
