Call Meeting to Order and Roll Call.

The Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

1. City Commission Redistricting Plans.

Mayor Carroll said the purpose of the meeting was to receive comments from the public on the proposed redistricting plans. The Commission had reviewed several plans and had narrowed it down to two plans, Plan 3-1 and Plan 4.

Mr. Michael Sharp, Research & Polling, Inc., gave a brief overview of the criteria used and the two redistricting plans.

At the request of Commissioner Moncada, Mr. Sharp noted the percentage of Hispanics within Districts 5 and 4 in Plan 3-1, and Districts 5 and 7 in Plan 4.

There were no questions or comments from the audience regarding the proposed plans. The Commission agreed to the scheduling of a second and final Public Hearing for August 14, 2001, at 7:30 p.m. in the Commission Chambers to obtain input from the public one last time and to select a redistricting plan. Mr. Sharp would not be attending the final Public Hearing, but he would be available telephonically if needed.

The Meeting was adjourned at 7:05 p.m.
