Call Meeting to Order and Roll Call.

The Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.

1. Review and Discuss City Commission Redistricting Plans.

Recommendation: Schedule Public Hearing for July 10, 2001 at 6:30 p.m. in the Commission Chambers.

Mr. Michael Sharp, Research & Polling, had today forwarded an alternative plan, Plan 3-1, based on suggestions he'd received from various Commissioners. Therefore, the plans which the Commission would be reviewing tonight were Plans 1, 2, 3, 3-1, and 4.

Mayor Carroll suggested that they look at each plan separately and perhaps eliminate those ones which the Commissioners were not necessarily in favor of.

Through the process of elimination, it was the consensus of the Commission to eliminate Plans 1, 2, and 3. Plans 3-1 and 4 were the two which would be left on the table and considered further. There was no objection to limiting the review to only those two plans. The Commission further agreed to the scheduling of a Public Hearing for July 10, 2001, at 6:30 p.m. in the Commission Chambers for further review and to obtain input from the public. In the meantime, they requested that the media be notified of the Public Hearing. Mr. Gaylon Parker of the "Alamogordo Daily News" said he would be printing the two proposed plans, in color, in a future issue of the newspaper. Also, the proposed plans would be displayed in the City Hall lobby, as well as at the Public Library.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Adjourn into Executive Session to discuss limited personnel matters.

Mayor Pro-Tem Van Doren moved to adjourn into Executive Session to discuss limited personnel matters. Seconded by Commissioner Cooper. All voted "aye". The motion carried by a roll call vote of 7-0-0. The Meeting was adjourned at 8:08 p.m.
