EXCITING NEWS!



Alamogordo MainStreet was one of only three districts in the state to receive dedicated architectural services and a New Mexico Resiliency Alliance grant for \$5,000 to improve three downtown district buildings in need through minor repairs, fresh coats of paint, and general curb appeal enhancements.

The MainStreet *Façade Squad* is currently working with the buildings' owner & New Mexico MainStreet specialists to finalize their plans for improvements on the three buildings on and near the corner of New York Avenue and 10th Street – to include Mission Billiards & the two unoccupied commercial office buildings adjacent.

After some locally contracted minor repairs & window replacements are accomplished, Alamogordo MainStreet will be seeking volunteers to assist in stripping paint from bricks and refreshing the building façades with fresh, historically accurate coats of paint! This project – and Façade Squad initiative as a whole – will improve the overall attractiveness and aesthetics of our downtown district by providing volunteer-driven bootstrap efforts through efficient and cost-effective ways for our community to make high impact visible improvements to the district.
