



National School Bus Safety Week October 16-20, 2017

School bus transportation plays a critical role in the education of our students and is the direct link between a neighborhood and the classroom. Several of our students ride the yellow bus every school day and National School Bus Safety Week serves as a reminder for students, parents, teachers and the community to keep school bus safety in the forefront. Here are tips to keep our children safe at the bus stop.

For Drivers

Bus Lights - School buses use yellow flashing lights to alert motorists that they are preparing to stop.

An extended stop sign signals that children are getting on or off.

Give them Room - Children are in the most danger in the 10 foot area surrounding a school bus. Stop far enough from the bus to allow the necessary space to safely enter and exit the bus.

Passing - It is illegal in all 50 states to pass a school bus that is stopped. NEVER pass a school bus on the right.

Look Out - Take extra care to look out for children in school zones, residential areas, playgrounds and parks.

For Students and Parents

- Wear bright colors so the bus driver and others can see you.
- Walk to the bus stop with a friend or parent. Don't talk to strangers on the way.
- Cross streets only at crosswalks or street corners.
- At the bus stop, stay safely away from the road.
- Don't push, yell or throw things while at the bus stop or on the bus.
- Use the and rail when getting on or off the bus.
- Stay seated on the bus and keep the aisle clear.
- NEVER put anything out of the bus window.
- Pay attention to the bus driver.
- Keep out of the Danger Zone, which is 10 feet all around the bus.
