The Otero & Lincoln County ServiceHeart CASA program is in need of volunteers to

ADVOCATE for children in foster care. They typically have 32 volunteers and serve over 140 children. CASA volunteers listen first, then they act. The children served have been removed from their homes due to abuse, neglect, or abandonment. Many feel very much alone—until they meet their CASA. A CASA volunteer devotes their attention to one child or a sibling group, closely monitoring each child's situation and ensuring their needs are met. A CASA is often the only consistent adult presence in a foster child's life - he is one person a child can truly count on who is not paid to oversee their welfare.

Paying Your City Utility Bill

The City of Alamogordo offers a number of ways to pay your utility bill!

- Check or Money Order (PLEASE - NO CASH!) via US Postal Service
- Cash, Check, Money Order, Debit/Credit Card in person with any of our cashiers at City Hall, 1376 E Ninth St., Monday thru Friday 8am – 5 pm.*
- Dropping your Check/Money Order (PLEASE - NO CASH!) in our payment drop box located at City Hall. Please be aware that payments dropped off after 8 am will not be processed until the next business day.
- Sign up for Auto Draft – we can draft your monthly utility payment directly from your bank or financial institution.
- On-Line via Credit/Debit Card and electronic check* On the City's website at www.ci.alamogordo.nm.us and click on the Online Bill Pay link.
- Via Telephone by dialing 575-439-4260 and selecting Option #2.*
- Through your financial institution. The City maintains an electronic lockbox that can receive payments from most financial institutions. Check with your financial institution to determine if they provide online payment services.

*NOTE: When paying by Credit/Debit card through our online provider, telephone, or at City Hall a processing fee will be added to your transaction.
