## Fire Prevention Week

During the week of October 7-13, the Alamogordo Fire Department will be participating in the National Fire Prevention Week, Fire Prevention Campaign. During this year's event, the Alamogordo Fire Department will be offering Fire Prevention Education, Home Safety and Evacuation Courses, Fire Extinguisher Training, Business Fire Safety Training, and Open House tours of our Fire Stations.

*The Alamogordo Fire Department wants to remind Alamogordo Residents to: "Look. Listen. Learn." Be aware - fire can happen anywhere.*

In a fire, seconds count, and can mean the difference between residents of our community escaping safely from a fire or having their lives end in tragedy.

In a fire, seconds count, did you know that the majority of fire deaths (four out of five) occur at a home each year? Recent research shows that the fire death rate (per 1000 home fires reported to fire departments across the nation) is now 10 percent higher in 2016 compared to 1980.

Through three simple calls-to-action, "Look. Listen. Learn. Be aware - fire can happen anywhere." identifies basic but essential ways people can reduce their risk to fire and be prepared in the event of one: Please see below.

- **Look** for places fire can start
- **Listen** for the sound of the smoke alarm
- **Learn** two ways out of each room

The Alamogordo Fire Department will be hosting activities during Fire Prevention Week to help promote the 2018 theme. Residents can learn more about the importance of: Look. Listen. Learn, having a home escape plan, two ways out, the importance of smoke alarms. 
