

New Mexico Public Libraries Bond will be on the ballot **November 6, 2018**. The Go Bond B Provides supplemental funding to academic, school, tribal and public libraries across the state. For Alamogordo Public Library this would mean more funds for books, DVDs, audiobooks, databases, and an upgraded security system. If the measure passes Otero County could receive \$280,649.15 for schools and libraries. The Alamogordo Public library would get \$106,507.09, an increase of \$27,967 from the previous issue.


