Alameda Park Zoo



WHO'S NEW AT THE ZOO?

Alameda Park Zoo has welcomed two Red Kangaroo Joeys (*Macropus rufus*)!

They weigh around 10 pounds now, born in May or June of this year. The Red Kangaroo, native to Australia, is the largest marsupial in the world. Males can weigh over 200 pounds, while the females usually don't get larger than 90 pounds. This species of kangaroo relies heavily on environmental cues for reproduction. The females can utilize what's called delayed implantation to optimize the joeys' survival, which is much higher in the spring and summer. This means the females can wait until it is the most optimal time for the fertilized egg to begin developing into a joey. Females give birth to just one jellybean-sized baby at a time after 33 days of pregnancy. This baby immediately crawls into mom's pouch, staying for up to 8 months for safety. Most babies are weaned from nursing by 12 months of age. Red Kangaroos will then forage on grasses, shrubs and forbs. Here at the zoo, we feed our Red Kangaroos bermuda hay and kangaroo chow made by the Mazrui Diets company. We hope you will come by to say hi to the new members of our zoo family.
