

## Alameda Park Zoo

With just 4 ingredients, you can craft a nature friendly bird feeder. The winter is the most trying season for birds. They have to keep themselves warm while they migrate, swim, and sleep at night, but there is a limited supply of good food.

### Pinecone Feeder

1. Grab some pinecones (*lots near the golf course and plenty available at the zoo*).
2. Closed pinecones can be opened by placing in a 300 degree oven for 10 minutes
3. Roll in or drizzle honey or peanut butter on the pinecone
4. Roll in or sprinkle on bird seed, crushed plain pecans, plain dried fruit, sunflower seeds
5. Use string or pipe cleaner to hang
