Tip of the Week!

From Traci Myers, PTA

1. Use proper footwear for best stability and support, such as nonskid socks or well-fitting tennis shoes
2. Install ample lighting inside and outdoors to prevent falls:
 - Bathrooms, hallways, near telephones, sidewalks and steps
3. Remove all throw rugs - trip hazard
4. To get up safely from seated position:
 - Scoot to edge of chair or bed
 - Push up with your arms to stand
 - Stand upright before you start to walk - balance check!
 - Use cane or walker if needed, and stay close to your assistive device
5. Avoid ladders and step stools - can cause a fall
6. STAY ACTIVE! Walk, take a class, do exercises you can safely do during TV commercial breaks

Helping community cats in your neighborhood



FREE spay/neuter for outdoor community cats!


Community cats are free-roaming, stray, or feral cats who live outdoor in your neighborhood. Alamogordo Animal Control has partnered with Kitty City NM and Best Friends Animal Society to humanely spay/neuter, vaccinate, and ear-tip community cats. (Ear-tipping is the universal symbol of a spayed or neutered outdoor cat.)

Once the cat recovers, they are returned to the area where the cat was originally found. Because these cats are spayed or neutered, their numbers are reduced over time.

Benefits of Spay/Neuter:

- Prevents unwanted litters
- Save taxpayer money by keeping cats out of the animal shelters
- Decreases killing of cats in over-crowded animal shelters
- Improves the health of outdoor cats
- Minimizes cat behaviors like spraying, fighting, howling, and roaming
