
### The Alamogordo Summer Adventures Challenge runs from May 15, 2019 through September 2, 2019

Due to the July 4th holiday, Thursday residential garbage collection will take place on Wednesday July 3rd.




## Alamogordo Public Library

# It's Coming... Online Registration July 2019

Parents and Guardians, we are hoping to make your life a little easier next school year with online registration! Online registration reduces paperwork. No need to fill out forms at the beginning of EVERY school year.

- Online registration will be available for ALL K-12 grade levels. Don't have access to a computer or internet? No problem! Computers will be available for registration at your child's school.
- If you have more than one child in school, you only need one ParentVUE account to update all of your child's information.
- Verify your child's address, phone number, email address and emergency contacts online. You can update your information anytime during the registration window by logging into ParentVUE.
- If you don't currently have a ParentVUE account set up, you can get your activation key from your child's school.

As with ANY school registration, you will still need to provide:

- Birth Certificate
- Immunizations
- Proof of Residency
- Emergency Contact Information
- Custodial Documentation (if applicable)
