Alamogordo Public Schools General Obligation Bond 2019

The question on the ballot asks voters to authorize the issuance of up to \$17,000,000 in general obligation bonds. **These funds will be used to design and build a new replacement facility for Chaparral Middle School.**



The NM Public School Facilities Authority has assessed Chaparral Middle School and ranked it #1 for replacement in the entire state. The State of New Mexico will pay for 60% of the total cost of the new school. Approval of this GO Bond on November 5th will supply the additional 40% and **WILL NOT** increase existing property tax rates, and will only maintain the current tax rate.
