

Here are some helpful tips for the holiday season:

- Inspect holiday lights each year for frayed wires.
- If you use holiday lights outside, make sure they are rated for outdoor use.
- Never use outside lights on your Christmas tree.
- Extinguish all candles when you leave the room or go to sleep; and keep them at least 12 inches away from walls.
- Have your chimney inspected at least once a year and cleaned and repaired as often as necessary.
- Store removed ashes in tightly covered metal containers, never in boxes or bags.
- Keep portable space heaters at least three feet away from walls, curtains, bedding or other materials that may burn.




Ultimately, the success of the census depends on everyone's participation. The 2020 Census is important for you and your community, and you can help.
