





Alamogordo Public Schools is with you, our families and community, during this difficult time. We actively follow the guidelines set forth by medical and government officials to try and keep our friends and families safe.

Rest assured that APS, while following safety protocols, has not forgotten about who we serve and the reason we exist: the children of our community. APS has been developing a plan to keep our kids learning through the remainder of this academic year.

This plan begins by making Chromebooks available to all families who do not have a computer of their own, one Chromebook per family. TDS Telecom has graciously offered to supply two months of free internet service to families with a student (call 1-844-239-9621 for service). In addition, APS has increased the Wi-Fi outside of various schools, and several other community organizations have done the same.

The next phase of Alamogordo Public Schools' Continuous Learning Plan begins in April with Digital Learning. Digital Learning is virtual learning, and it is different because sessions are shorter and students are not in class "all day". For those families who do not have home internet there will be digital assignments that can be downloaded at the local schools, possibly most conveniently when the family is picking up the child's "Grab 'N Go" lunches, or at other Wi-Fi hotspots around Alamogordo. There will be some adjustments to make, but remember we are learning to provide digital learning at the same time we are teaching it, so we ask for your patience and understanding as we enter into this next phase of education. NEW Visiting Hours Policy

As of Wednesday March 25, 2020 - to protect our patients and staff during the increased risk of exposure to COVID-19 virus, **no visitors will be allowed in the facility.** In special circumstances, up to two visitors per patient may be permitted for patients undergoing end-of-life care, pediatric patients, emergency surgery and Cardiac Catheterization. Labor and delivery patients may have one support person.

For those visitors allowed and ambulatory patients for lab, diagnostic imaging, cardiopulmonary and infusion the following applies:

- Visitors experiencing flu-like symptoms (cough, shortness of breath, fever) or have travel history to a high risk area in the past 14 days or have been exposed to COVID-19 are prohibited from entering the facility unless seeking care.
- Visitors will be screened upon entry to facility and temperature taken to rule out fever.
- We encourage family members and/or non-visitors to utilize "tele-visit" options such as phone calls, Face-time, Skype, WhatsApp and other online platforms.

CRITERIA FOR CORONAVIRUS TESTING

Patients experiencing the following symptoms or meeting the conditions listed below may receive Coronavirus testing at the GCRMC Satellite Lab:

- Fever (Temperature higher than 100 F)
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Over age 65
- History of cardiac disease, diabetes or COPD.



Testing is done by appointment only. Call the scheduling line 575-443-7505 to schedule for the COVID-19 testing.
