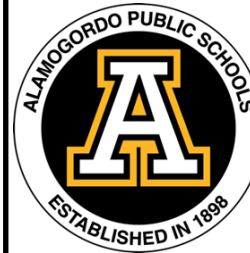

It's that time of year when the days get shorter and the temperature gets colder. Students in pre-K through Grade 5 returned to classrooms in October to a socially distanced hybrid learning environment. This means the students attend in-person classes two days a week and attend school virtually for the other three. The days that students attend are determined by which cohort they were assigned to: "A" attends Monday and Tuesday; "B" attends Thursday and Friday. The classroom looks different than in the past, as students are distanced at least six feet from each other and wear masks throughout the school day. Wednesday is a cleaning day as buildings are cleaned and sterilized. As the fall progresses and temperatures drop, flu and cold season will likely add to the continuing Covid-19 situation. We at Alamogordo Public Schools wish to remind everyone to keep safe during this holiday season. GCRMC continues to evolve and prepare as COVID-19 increases in Otero County over the fall and winter. A COVID-19 unit is available with 17 beds available, there is an average of eight patients in the COVID-19 Unit. Every person admitted to the hospital is given a rapid polymerase chain reaction, or PCR, test prior to being assigned a bed. GCRMC averages 80 polymerase chain reaction (PCR) tests each day. A Drive-in satellite lab will be opening soon by appointment only. Also, be aware that telemedicine visits are available. For more information call 575-443-7505.
