

The new year has brought hope due to several vaccinations becoming available for Covid-19, and the entire state of New Mexico progressing toward green status, even though we're still in the red. Although we are improving we are not back to normal just yet. The one bright spot out of the trying year that 2020 turned out to be was the incredible acceptance and expansion of technology in the learning and teaching process. While Alamogordo Public Schools was moving forward toward a one device for every student status before Covid-19, the pandemic accelerated this by years. 



COVID-19 UPDATE NM HEALTH DEPARTMENT

'RED TO GREEN' COUNTY-BY-COUNTY COVID-19 FRAMEWORK

- ESSENTIAL RETAIL:** 25% of maximum occupancy or 75 customers, whichever is smaller
- FOOD & DRINK ESTABLISHMENTS:** No indoor dining, outdoor dining allowed at 25% of maximum occupancy, establishments serving alcohol must close by 9PM
- HOUSES OF WORSHIP:** 25% of maximum occupancy
- PLACES OF LODGING:** 40% of maximum occupancy for those that are NM Safe Certified, 25% for those that are not, 5 guests max for vacation rentals
- ESSENTIAL BUSINESSES:** Must limit operations to only those absolutely necessary to carry out essential functions

MASS GATHERINGS LIMIT: 5 persons, 10 vehicles

CLOSE-CONTACT BUSINESSES: 25% of maximum occupancy or 10 customers at one time, whichever is smaller

OUTDOOR RECREATIONAL FACILITIES: 25% of maximum occupancy

CLOSE-CONTACT RECREATIONAL FACILITIES: Remain closed

ALL OTHER BUSINESSES, INCLUDING NON-ESSENTIAL RETAIL STORES & GYMS: 25% of maximum occupancy or 75 customers at one time, whichever is smaller

COVID Vaccine Registration

Vaccinenm.org is a registration and inventory management system that enables health care partners to manage real-time vaccine demand while increasing distribution efficiency and minimizing waste. Since its release in December, vaccinenm.org has seen more than 230,000 registrations - one in every ten New Mexicans. State officials believe it is the only system of its kind in the country.

The state will also launch a vaccine call center sometime in January, providing additional support for those who wish to register or ask questions about the process. A news release will accompany the call center launch.
