City Ordinance 14-01-020 includes a provision that “No person shall dump, deposit, place or dispose of any trash, debris, junk, or other matter on public property.” This includes the prohibition of dumping or disposal of debris throughout the City’s drainage system. Many local flood problems are caused when trash, yard waste or other debris is dumped into channels which can clog culverts, divert flows, and reduce capacity in channels. DOH will continue to prioritize vaccine invitations for Phase 1A, New Mexicans 75 years and older, and New Mexicans 60 years and older with a chronic condition. The Department has chosen to open Phase 2, the final distribution phase because providers in some parts of the state are no longer able to fill appointments within Phases 1A, 1B, & 1C.
