October 19th - Last day to request an absentee ballot.

October 30th - Absentee & early voting ends.

November 2nd - Election Day! Voting from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm at all 16 Voting Convenience Centers. In Alamogordo: Sgt. Willie Estrada Memorial Civic Center, Tays Special Events Center, and the Otero County Fairgrounds.

November 9th - County Commissioners will certify the canvass of returns.

November 23rd - The State begins its canvass


Holloman Air Force Base Operation Allies Welcome
