How to apply for a Burn Permit



The application for a burn permit, as well as a listing of adopted International Fire Code Requirements, can be found on the City's AFD page at tinyurl.com/ymnwdede

- The application on that page must be filled in by hand and turned into Fire Station-1. A paper copy of the application can also be picked up at Fire Station-1, Monday-Friday from 8am to 5pm.
- The application will be reviewed and forwarded to Fire Personnel.
- The burn site will be inspected by Fire Personnel for permit compliance; the permit will be either approved or denied after inspection.
- If the permit is approved, the citizen will be contacted to go to City Hall and pay a \$15 Permit Fee, whereafter the citizen will receive the permit.

Note: The total process takes 24 to 72 hours. Approved burn permits are issued for a two week period.
