

No watering on Mondays, all watering must take place before 9 am and after 6 pm

Code Enforcement

Beginning on May 1st, water conservation measures go into effect. What does this mean for you? Between May 1st and November 1st, the watering of grass, trees, plants and other vegetation are prohibited between 9 am and 6 pm. Outside of those times, if your house number ends with a 2, 4, 6, or 8 you can water your grass on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday. Others may water on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday. Why? The overuse of water could deplete the city's water supply causing stricter use regulations which may include only being permitted to use water on certain days. For more information the code can be found on the city's website. **Code: 28-03-033. - Water conservation**
