Knowing that schools are the one place that kids and families can get to most of the time, Alamogordo Public Schools (APS) developed programs and links to community resources that operate out of the HUB located near 12th and Florida. The **HOPE** program is a team of counselors and a social worker addressing crisis situations and assisting families with reintegration into school after a hospitalization.

The **Flo RV** is the health services mobile unit providing vaccinations, testing, dental screenings, prevention education and mental health information.

The **Fresh Start Program** addresses hygiene concerns. APS is installing a washer and dryer in every school, allowing eligible students to do laundry.

Beds For Kids is available for students who do not have a bed to sleep on.

Test 2 Stay allows students to stay at school despite close contact to a Covid case. With negative test results, students can fully participate in school activities. Otherwise, students are required by the state to stay home for five days.

FORCES (Family Outreach Resource Center for Educational Services) provides community classes such as Grandparents Parenting: The Second Time Around. For more information about these and future programs, contact HOPE@alamogordoschools.org or 575-812-6094.
