



Suspect Child Abuse? Now What Do You Do? NM law requires that anyone who knows or has reasonable suspicion that a child is being abused or neglected must report it immediately to CYFD's (Children, Youth & Families Department's) Statewide Central Intake child abuse hotline (1-855-333-SAFE [7233] or #SAFE), or to law enforcement or the appropriate tribal authority.

Proof of abuse or neglect is not required, only a reasonable suspicion. You may choose to remain anonymous when making a report.

Children can report for themselves or a friend 24-hours a day through CYFD's program, "Reach New Mexico," by texting 505-591-9444. CYFD will answer questions via text and connect children with support.. If neglect or abuse is suspected, a report will be made so investigators can respond.
