Housing is a Basic Need
Housing insecurity spans a range of situations and can be caused by, and create, adverse childhood experiences (ACEs), traumatic events experienced during childhood. Being unhoused puts individuals at high risk for any number of negative outcomes. There is no dedicated overnight shelter, or transitional housing resource in Otero County. There are agencies which assist with applications, acquiring basic needs or rental deposits. FEMA recently issued funds to provide a night or two at a hotel, helping someone get off the street. Contact Nadia Sikes at The Counseling Center, 575-921-1667. The 100% Otero Housing Team, Love, INC. and Mountain View Church, will host an outreach event, The Day of Hope on Saturday November 5th, 10am - 2pm at Mountain View Church, 1300 Cuba Avenue. For those that are unhoused or housing insecure, a free lunch, many services, and application assistance will be offered.
