All Declarations of Candidacies shall be filed in the Office of the Otero County Clerk on August 29, 2023, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

All Declarations of Candidacy for write-in candidates shall be filed in the Office of the County Clerk on September 5, 2023, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

September 5, 2023, is the last day to withdraw as a candidate for the Regular Local Election.



Outdoor Water Schedule

Effective May 1st through November 1st. Street number ends in 1,3,5,7,9 you may only water on Sundays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. Street number ends in 0,2,4,6,8 you may only water on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays. All outdoor watering must take place before 9 a.m. and after 6 p.m. Watering is not permitted on Mondays.
