We're thrilled to announce the birth of our very first Addax calf! These desert antelopes were once found all over Africa, but today fewer than 100 remain in the wild. Uncontrolled hunting, droughts, habitat loss, and regional conflicts have led to a dramatic decline in their numbers. Addax are now critically endangered.
