- ★ Advise on how trends in the community are affecting seniors.



Pet owners of Alamogordo, do you know your dogs and cats need a license? The can be obtained by taking your pet's current rabies vaccination paperwork to the Animal Control office at 2910 N Florida, between the hours of 12 and 5 p.m., Monday—Saturday.



- If your pet is spayed/neutered or under 6 months old the cost is \$5 per year.
- If your pet is over 6 months old and is not spayed/neutered the cost is \$25 per year.
