An Election will be held in the City of Alamogordo on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 for the purpose of electing one (1) District 2 City Commissioner, one (1) District 4 City Commissioner, one (1) District 6 City Commissioner, one (1) Mayor (At-Large) and (1) Municipal Judge. In only Districts 2, 4, and 6 will the ballot contain a position for City Commissioner. The election will be Citywide (Districts 1 through 6) as well as the Mayor At-Large position and the Municipal Judge position at the time the election resolution is adopted.

Any registered elector of the City of Alamogordo may be a candidate for the office of City Commissioner, Mayor At-Large and Municipal Judge. There is only one day to file for office and that is on **TUESDAY, JANUARY 9, 2018, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:00 A.M. AND 5:00 P.M., AT THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK.** There will be a **CANDIDATE TRAINING** on **JANUARY 3, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. in the Chambers at City Hall** for any interested candidates. All prospective candidates are encouraged to contact the City Clerk, Rachel Hughs at 575-439-4205 to receive a candidate packet, available on December 28, 2017.
