An Election will be held in the City of Alamogordo on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 for the purpose of electing one (1) District 2 City Commissioner, one (1) District 4 City Commissioner, one (1) District 6 City Commissioner, one (1) Mayor (At-Large) and (1) Municipal Judge. In only Districts 2, 4, and 6 will the ballot contain a position for City Commissioner. The election will be Citywide (Districts 1 through 6) as well as the Mayor At-Large position and the Municipal Judge position at the time the election resolution is adopted.

Ordinance Changes

On December 19, 2017 the Alamogordo City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 1544 which made changes to the City of Alamogordo water and sewer charges. A summary of the changes are:

1. Increases subdivision lot exemption to 5 years with possibility of 3 year extension.
2. Adds language to include original developer, successor or assignee.
3. Adds language that allows lots not in a subdivision and never developed to be removed from paying base rates.
4. Adds language that utility accounts transferred to owner by the City will only be charged the water base rate unless there is recorded water usage. (Accounts initiated after 12/25/2017)
5. Creates a modified base rate of \$10.00 per month for lot(s)/parcel(s) on which no structure currently exists. (Effective 02/01/2018)
6. Eliminates residential property owner deposit
7. Eliminates commercial property owner deposit
8. Provide mechanism for rental property owners to eliminate the \$25.00 transfer fee
9. Adds \$25.00 per month hydrant meter rental fee.
