

Alamogordo Outdoor Watering Schedule is effective **May 1, 2017 through November 1, 2017.**

By Ordinance, the outdoor watering schedule each year is:

Odd numbered addresses (street number ends in 1, 3, 5, 7, 9) **May only water on: Sunday, Wednesday & Friday.**

Even numbered addresses (street number ends in 0, 2, 4, 6, 8) **May only water on: Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday.**

All outdoor watering must take place **BEFORE 9:00 am** or **AFTER 6:00 pm.**

**\*Outdoor watering is NOT permitted on Mondays\***
