In only Districts 2, 4, and 6 will the ballot contain a position for City Commissioner. Alamogordo Police Department

Alamogordo Police Department is excited to announce that it has earned reaccreditation with the New Mexico Law Enforcement Professional Standards Council (NMLEPSC) through the New Mexico Municipal League for another 3 years. Accreditation is a voluntary ongoing process whereby agencies evaluate policy and procedure against established criteria, and have compliance of that criteria verified by an independent and authoritative body. Agencies must stand for reaccreditation every three years, a process which includes an in-depth on-site assessment, including interviews, review of protocols and procedures and riding along with officers in the field to verify that policies and procedures are actually in practice. “This award of accreditation signifies continued department proficiency and excellence and that



we are a well-rounded department. I want to thank the command staff for all their help, and I’m proud of the whole department.” said Acting Chief of Police Roger Schoolcraft.
