As the summer holidays are fast approaching, we at Animal Control wish to offer this helpful advice.

1. Not all foods are safe for dogs. Onions, chocolate, coffee, grapes, raisins, and avocado are very bad for your four legged furry pals.
2. Dogs and thunderstorms don't mix. Please make sure they are comfortable in a safe place during thunderstorms. If they become frightened and run off, they can be hit by cars.
3. Travelling increases. If you are travelling far from home with your pet you may want to add a tag with your temporary address and a cell phone number in case your pet gets out away from home.
4. Sunscreen and insect repellent should **only be used on pets if the product is labeled as safe for the pet!!!**
5. **NEVER** leave your pet unattended in a vehicle, especially with the rising summer temperatures.
