Blighted Structures Removed

Alamogordo, NM Thursday, October 21, 2021 The City of Alamogordo is pleased to announce that three blighted homes have been demolished and removed from the community. Structures at 1113 Catalina, 2414 Telles, and 704 Panorama that were eyesores for many years in the community have now gone through the legal process and have been removed.

City Manager Brian Cesar said “I am happy that some of the structures that have long plagued and blighted Alamogordo have been removed. We are working hard to remove blighted properties, but it can be a long and tedious process, as the City attempts to balance public safety with the rights of property owners. I would encourage everyone to do their part and to keep their homes safe and free from dilapidation.”

The City is now looking for its next group of blighted or dilapidated structures to start the removal process with. New Mexico State Law defines a building as dilapidated when it is a “...menace to the public comfort, health, peace or safety”. As such, if you know of a building that would fit these terms, please send an email to blight@ci.alamogordo.nm.us to have the structure evaluated by the City.
